## **Outreach & Education Charge**

- To focus on reducing the use of electricity and heating fuels in the built environment, with secondary emphasis on increasing the acceptance and use of renewable energy, and reducing the use of transportation fuels.

- 3. Facilitate institutionalization of the unique, successful, NH-centric efforts to engage consumers in efficiency




### **BUTTON UP NH: Partner Goal**
