### **Objective – what difference do we want to make**

The objective of the EESE Board is to move the NH state economy forward through prudent increases in spending and investment for appropriate EE and SE programs.

We will measure the results by estimating the benefits of such spending and investment and by monitoring the ACEEE rankings.

### **Goals – what specific things can we do that will make a difference**

### **Programs – what activities can we undertake to achieve our goals**

Engage with the legislature and other “Energy Plan” stakeholders

Engage stakeholders on their EE and SE programs and facilitate / encourage improvements

Provide T/A and support to municipalities

Develop and track a list of current / emerging EE and SE issues – discuss and provide recommendations to the PUC and others

Re-align outreach and education efforts with priority goals

Hold Energy Forums open to a broader public on key topics

Develop a mechanism for monitoring EE / SE spending and benefits
