At the December 13, 2013 meeting of the Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Energy (EESSE) Board, the Board discussed recommendations made in the Energy Efficiency Resource Standard Study (*Final Report, Increasing Energy Efficiency in New Hampshire: Realizing Our Potential*). One result of the discussion was a motion requesting the Public Utilities Commission to initiate a stakeholder process. The following motion was made, seconded and approved unanimously by all voting members present at the meeting:

The EESSE Board communicate in writing to the Public Utilities Commission to request that the Commission initiate an informal, non-adjudicatory stakeholder process, at its earliest convenience, on the subject of whether and how to move forward on an Energy Efficiency Resource Standard, using the November 15, 2013 *Final Report, Increasing Energy Efficiency in New Hampshire: Realizing Our Potential* as an input.
