At the December 13, 2013 meeting of the Energy Efficiency and Sustainable Energy (ESEE) Board, the Board discussed recommendations made in the Energy Efficiency Resource Standard Study (Final Report, Increasing Energy Efficiency in New Hampshire: Realizing Our Potential). One result of the discussion was a motion requesting certain information from utility companies. The following motion was made, seconded and approved unanimously by all voting members present at the meeting:

The ESEE Board send a written request to the utilities inviting them, to the extent resources allow, to conduct an analysis of the rate impact of achieving a reduction in energy use equivalent to 1.6% of 2012 electric sales, as outlined in the November 15, 2013 Final Report, Increasing Energy Efficiency in New Hampshire: Realizing Our Potential.
