“A policy that sets specific targets or goals for energy savings, which utility companies must meet.”

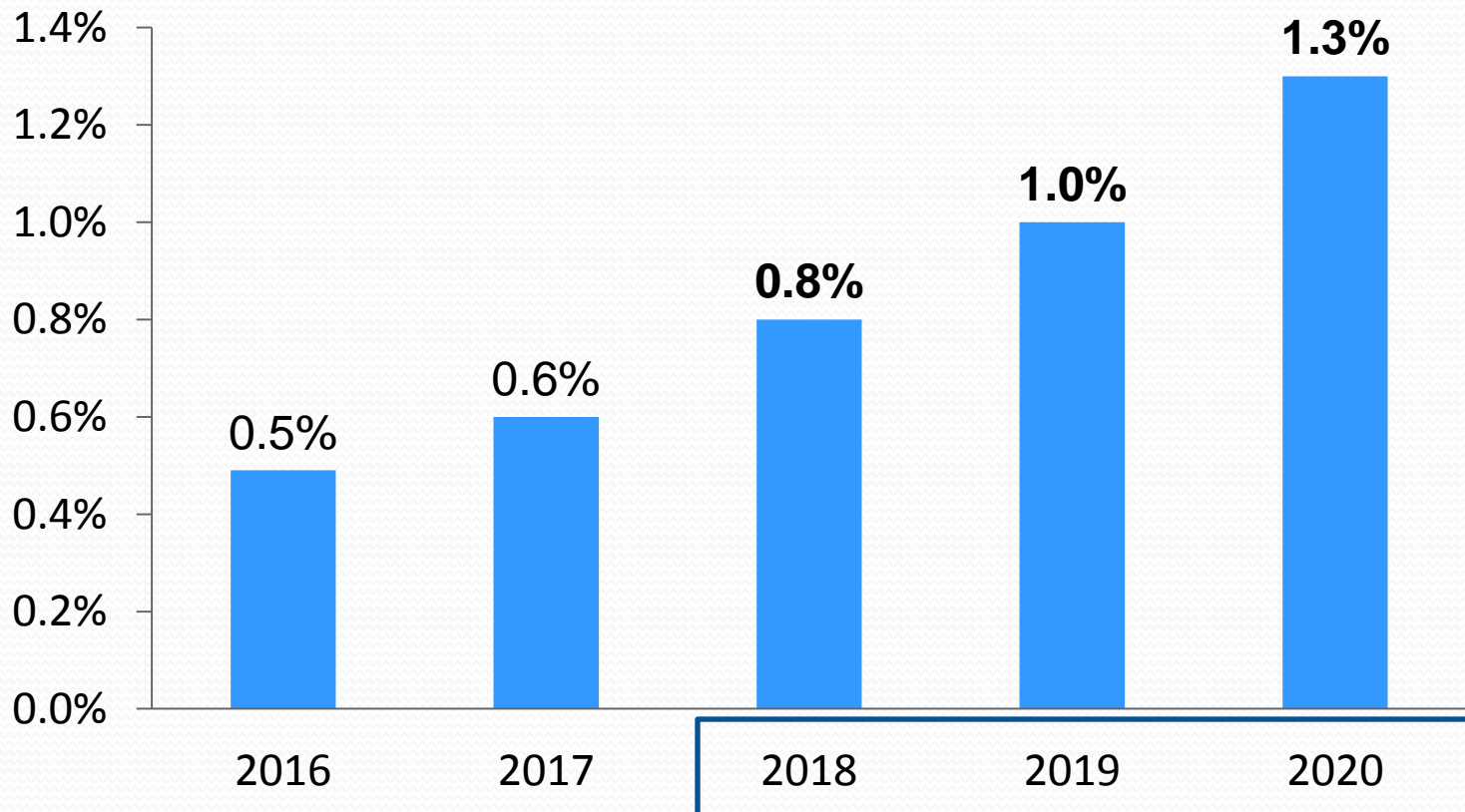

(% of 2014 Delivered Sales)



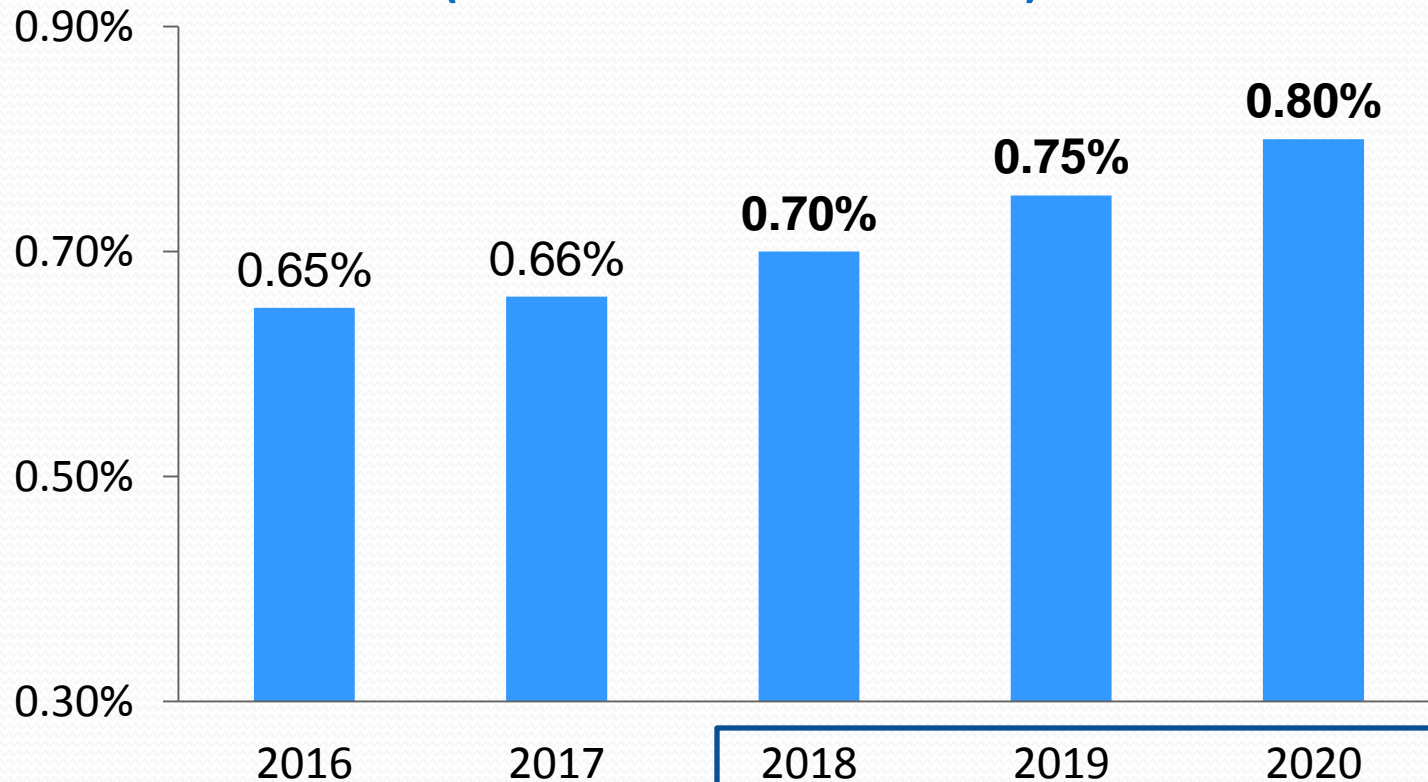

Natural Gas Utilities

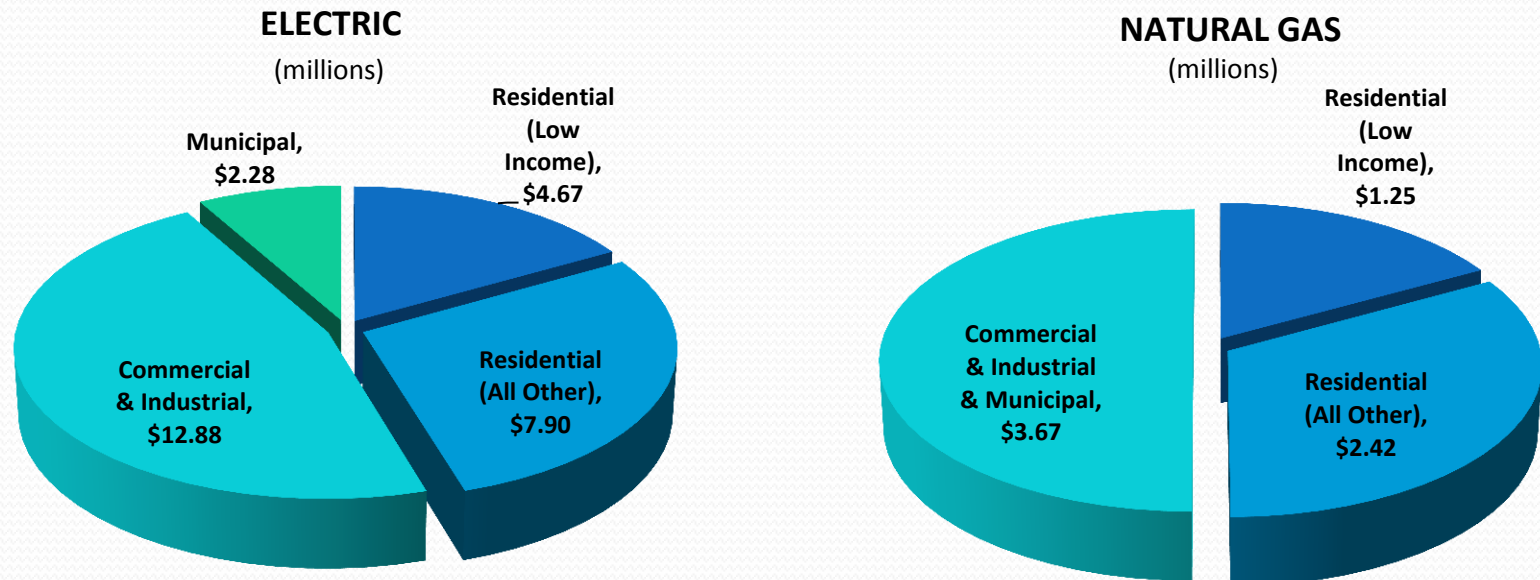
Annual Statewide Savings Targets

2017 Budgets

- Encourage builders to construct homes that are at least 15% more efficient than code-built homes
- Improve the efficiency of the existing homes by assisting customers with air sealing, insulation, and appliance and lighting upgrades – separate focus on income eligible customers
- Work with over 100 retailers to help customers purchase highly efficient appliances and light bulbs
- Work with businesses and non-profits to identify and install more efficient equipment and lighting
- Focus on municipalities to help save energy in public buildings
