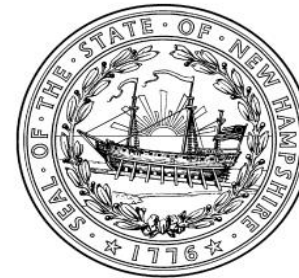

  - Per the PUC, the EESE Board is the convening body for stakeholder input into the plan.
  - Desired Outcomes:
    - Broad support across a diverse group of stakeholders for the plan to be filed in September.
    - A recommendation from the EESE Board to the PUC that the plan be approved.
  - The desired outcomes may or may not be achieved.
