Re: DW 04-048, City of Nashua Petition for Valuation Pursuant to RSA 38:9 Extension of Time

To the Parties:

On June 4, 2010, the City of Nashua (Nashua) filed an Assented to Motion to Extend the Deadline for Filing Contracts in the above referenced matter. Condition No. 8 of Order No. 24,878 (07/25/08) requires Nashua to submit executed agreements with Veolia Water and R.W. Beck within 60 days of the order becoming final and no longer subject to appeal. In its June 4<sup>th</sup> request, Nashua states that RSA 38:13 allows the Nashua Board of Alderman to decide whether or not to ratify the Commission's decision "[within 90 days of the final determination of the price to be paid for the plant and property." According to Nashua, the Board of Alderman has not authorized or executed the agreements pending its decision pursuant to RSA 38:13. Nashua, therefore, requests leave to file the authorized and executed agreements until the "earlier date of the decision of the Nashua Board of Alderman pursuant to RSA 38:13 or September 30, 2010." Pennichuck Water Works assents to the request

The Commission has determined pursuant to Puc 202.04 that the request is reasonable and would not unduly delay the proceeding or adversely affect the rights of any party. Accordingly, Nashua's request is granted.
