



Amendment of Estimate

Dear Executive Director Howland,

Sprint Communications Company, L.P. and Sprint Spectrum, L.P. (collectively “Sprint”) file this letter to amend its earlier submitted estimate. As described in the Commission’s letter detailing the events of the November 5, 2008 technical session, Sprint was directed to submit an estimate of its claim to the Commission. Verizon and Sprint both filed with the Commission estimates of the amount disputed between the parties. Following a review of Verizon’s estimate, Sprint has determined that its own estimate had a flaw in the calculation methodology. This inadvertent error led to a significant undercounting of the amount in dispute. Accordingly, Sprint will amend its preliminary estimate. To simplify the task at hand, however, Sprint will simply adopt the Verizon preliminary estimate rather than submit a duplicative or contrary estimate. Sprint finds that the Verizon calculation is reasonably accurate and that any differences Sprint would otherwise have are sufficiently minimal that Sprint will forgo any dispute over those amounts. Sprint attaches to this letter a copy of the Verizon estimate and Sprint declares that this estimate will also serve as Sprint’s estimate.

Sprint requests that the enclosed materials receive confidential treatment pursuant to RSA 378:43. The information contained on the attached disk are not publicly available, are not published elsewhere, are subject to procedures and measures that are intended to prevent its dissemination in the ordinary course of business, and this information is pertinent to the provision of competitive services in New Hampshire. Pursuant to the procedures discussed during the technical session held November 5, 2008, Sprint submits the enclosed materials to be held in confidence by the Commission.
