Dear Ms. Howland:

On November 20, 2007, Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) filed a petition for approval of power purchase agreements (PPAs) with Pinetree Power, Inc. and Pinetree Power-Tamworth, Inc. (collectively, "Pinetree"). Docket No. DE 07-125. In the petition, PSNH stated that, through the PPAs, the Company would be purchase energy, capacity and NH Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs). On December 26, 2007, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a letter with the Commission indicating that the OCA will participate in Docket No. DE 07-125 on behalf of residential ratepayers pursuant to RSA 363:28.

Pursuant to an Order of Notice issued December 18, 2007, a prehearing conference was held on January 31, 2008. No entity or person petitioned for intervention at the prehearing conference. Following the prehearing conference, a technical session was held among the OCA, Staff and PSNH. Staff had issued data requests on January 31, 2008 and supplemented those requests at the technical session. The OCA also made discovery requests at the technical session, and the parties and Staff agreed that PSNH will provide written responses to all data requests on February 11, 2008. The parties and Staff further agreed that no testimony was required in this proceeding. Therefore, the parties and Staff request that the Commission approve the following procedural schedule:

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PSNH Response to Data Requests February 11, 2008
Hearing March 5, 2008 at 10:00 a.m.
