Dear Mr. Cournoyer:

On February 19, 2008, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a notice of intent to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation services in New Hampshire from UMG, Inc (UMG). Staff has reviewed your application and has noted the following items which must be addressed before UMG's application can be approved:

- 1) Puc 2003.02 (c) requires "an electronic copy on diskette" to be filed with the notification. Please supply a diskette.
- 2) UMG stated in its application that the "service areas limited to commercial and industrial customers". Puc 2003.02 (c) (6) requires a "[D]escription of the geographic areas of New Hampshire in which the applicant intends to provide service, consistent with Puc 2003.01 (c) (11)". The geographic areas can be described as a "distribution company's existing franchise area, existing town boundaries, or a map with the boundary limits delineated". Please specify the geographic areas in which UMG intends to provide service

Please address these discrepancies within 30 days so that Staff may proceed with your

request to renew your registration as an aggregator of electric services. Failure to respond in a timely manner may result in the Commission dismissing, without prejudice, UMG's application. Also, please be advised that you should reference the docket number, DM 08-026, in all future correspondence with the Commission. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
