Dear Mr. Coffey:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received Green Power Management's (GPM) notice of intent to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire pursuant to Puc 2003.02. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.02. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves GPM's application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.02 (f): "[E]ach aggregator shall re-file with the commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date." GPM's original notice anniversary date is June 16, 2006 and therefore it is required to re-file an up-to-date written notice on or before **June 16, 2010** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, GPM is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
