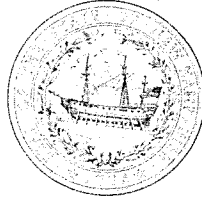

Dear Mr. Orr:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received US Energy Management Services' (USEMS) notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.02. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.02. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves USEMS' application to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please bear in mind the following provision of Puc 2003.02 (f) which requires each aggregator to re-file with the Commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date. USEMS' original notice anniversary date is July 25, 2008 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before **July 25, 2010** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, USEMS is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
