Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission Order No. 24,909, dated October 29, 2008 Docket DG 08-106 ("October Order"), EnergyNorth Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a National Grid NH herewith files an original and eight copies of its adjusted 2008-09 Winter Cost of Gas rates to be effective April 1, 2009. These adjusted rates require no further Commission action because they are within the minimum and maximum rates set forth in the October Order.

The adjusted cost of gas rates are being filed to reflect an update of the winter period deferred gas cost balance and the projected commodity prices for the remainder of the winter period. The attached estimated cost of gas was calculated using the 15 day average NYMEX settle prices as of March 24, 2009. Accordingly, these adjustments decrease the average cost of gas residential rate by \$0.1012 per therm and \$0.1010 and \$0.1013 per therm for the Low Winter Use and High Winter Use Commercial and Industrial rates, respectively. This rate decrease is capped at the minimum rates allowed in the October Order. Specifically, the Residential Cost of Gas Rate is decreased from \$1.0482 per therm to \$0.9470 per therm. Similarly, the Commercial/Industrial Low Winter Use Rate is decreased from \$1.0471 per therm to \$0.9461 per therm, and the Commercial/Industrial High Winter Use Rate is decreased from \$1.0484 per therm to \$0.9471 per therm.

The calculation indicates that absent the adjustment there would be an estimated over collection of gas costs as of April 30, 2009 of approximately \$2,868,091 or -2.61%. However, due to the minimum rate limit, the Company is proposing to reduce the over collection by \$930,085 or -0.85% at this time. The Company proposes to carry forward the remaining over recovery balance of \$1,938,006 until the Winter 2009-2010 cost of gas filing, as a prior period adjustment.
