In Case No. 2009-0168, Appeal of Union Telephone <u>Company d/b/a Union Communications</u>, the court on April 21, 2009, issued the following order:

Attorney Robert J. Munnelly, Jr.'s application to appear pro hac vice is granted. MetroCast Cablevision of New Hampshire LLC's motion for summary affirmance is denied.

If Attorney Cameron F. Kerry intends to participate in this case on behalf of Comcast Phone of New Hampshire, LLC, he shall file a verified application to appear pro hac vice in accordance with Rule 33(1) on or before May 6, 2009. The application should be accompanied by the non-refundable application fee of \$225.00, or by evidence that the fee was previously paid in a related or consolidated matter. See Rule 33(5).

Case is accepted and will be scheduled for oral argument before the full court.

On or before June 22, 2009, the Public Utilities Commission shall file with the supreme court a certified copy of the record in the proceeding. The certified copy of the record shall include a table of contents with references to the page of the record at which each item listed in the table of contents begins. See Rule 10(3). Any transcript of the proceeding before the Public Utilities Commission shall be filed with the certified copy of the record.
