This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received World Energy Solutions, Inc.'s (World Energy) notice of intent to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire pursuant to Puc 2003.02. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.02. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves World Energy's application to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire pursuant to Puc 2003.02.

Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.02 (f): "[E]ach aggregator shall re-file with the commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date." World Energy's original notice anniversary date is November 16, 2006 and therefore it is required to re-file an up-to-date written notice on or before **November 16, 2010** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, World Energy is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.07, customer protections provided by aggregators.
