Dear Ms. Glenn:

On February 17, 2009, you submitted a letter on behalf of WM Renewable Energy, L.L.C. (WMRE) notifying the Commission of the expansion of its Mill Seat landfill methane gas facility (Mill Seat facility) as required by the N.H. Code Admin. Rule Puc 2500. Previously, on December 22, 2008, the Commission had certified the Mill Seat facility as eligible to produce Class I renewable energy certificates pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard law and issued the facility the New Hampshire Renewable Portfolio Standard certification code NH-I-08-020.

WMRE's February 17<sup>th</sup> letter states that WMRE installed two additional 3516 engines, thereby increasing the gross nameplate capacity of the facility from its initial size of 4.8 megawatts to 6.4 megawatts that was commercially operational on December 17, 2008. Staff has reviewed your filing and recommended the Commission grant the additional capacity as eligible to produce renewable energy certificates effective June 08, 2009, the date on which Staff was able to verify that WMRE expanded its Mill Seat facility.

The Commission has reviewed the WMRE filing and determined that it has provided all the necessary information to demonstrate that the Mill Seat facility has increased its capacity. Therefore, the Commission hereby certifies that Mill Seat's additional capacity is eligible as a Class I renewable energy source effective June 08, 2009 and is eligible to be issued New Hampshire Class I renewable energy certificates.
