On June 28, 2016, the Commission issued Order No. 25,943 in the above captioned docket. As part of that order, the Commission noted that Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) had agreed to provide certain reports and information relating to its Reliability Enhancement Program (“REP”). Relevant to this submission, Eversource was to provide, on or about August 1 and every three months thereafter, a report on the status of its Geographic Information System (“GIS”) and the related Field Connectivity Survey. Eversource provided its initial report on August 2, 2016.

Following consultations with Commission Staff, this submission is being provided “off-cycle” so as to shift the three month requirement to coincide with regular calendar quarters. After this shift, Eversource will continue reporting on a three month cycle until at least May 1, 2017 or the date upon which the report will have final data on the completed Connectivity Project and no additional GIS-related charges are anticipated to REP, consistent with Order No. 25,943.
