Pursuant to New Hampshire Commission Order 22,236, Union Telephone Company ("Union") hereby informs the Commission that it has received an Interconnection Demand Letter on April 27, 2009 from IDT America, Corp. ("IDT"). While IDT has corresponded concerning its desire for interconnection in the past, this correspondence represents the first request by IDT for interconnection while it holds authority to provide service in the service area of Union.¹
