METROCAST CABLEVISION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE, LLC'S REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL REPLY MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to the Court's March 3, 2010 procedural order ("Order"), Appellee MetroCast Cablevision of New Hampshire, LLC ("MetroCast") requests leave to file a reply memorandum to address arguments raised in the Supplemental Briefs filed by the Appellant Union Telephone Company ("Union") and the Appellee Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission"), as well as the Amicus New Hampshire Telephone Association ("NHTA"). As grounds therefor, MetroCast states that the Supplemental Briefs raise heretofore new arguments that should be responded to for the Court's benefit. Accordingly, MetroCast requests leave to prepare and file a supplemental reply memorandum within a time period established by the Court.
