Complaint of Clean Power Development, LLC Against Public Service of New Hampshire

Dear Secretary Howland:

In previous filings made by PSNH in this proceeding, we committed to keep the Commission updated on the status of FERC Docket No. QM10-4, wherein PSNH sought a waiver of the mandate under PURPA to purchase the output from certain Qualifying Facilities.¹

Today, the FERC issued the attached "Order Denying Rehearing" regarding PSNH's rehearing request. The Order states that the issue of whether Clean Power Development is "grandfathered" under PURPA and able to seek a PURPA rate order from the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission depends on state law. "If the New Hampshire commission decides that Clean Power has indeed followed proper state procedures, and that a contract or legally enforceable obligation results from the Clean Power petition, then and only then will that contract or legally enforceable obligation be grandfathered and not subject to our April 15 termination order." Order at 10.

This FERC Order concludes the proceeding before Docket No. QM10-4, and PSNH does not intend to take any further action regarding that matter.
