On behalf of Granite State Electric Company d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid" or "Company"), I am submitting revised schedules to the testimony of David E. Tufts filed on May 15, 2009 in this docket. The revisions to Mr. Tufts' schedules are the result of the Company's request to implement the rate changes proposed in this docket effective for usage on and after August 1, 2009 rather than on and after July 1, 2009, as initially proposed. These changes are required due to the scheduling of a hearing in this docket on July 16, 2009. Please note that the Company is still proposing to recover the incremental O&M expense of \$113,832 above the base O&M amount of \$1,360,000 through the REP/VMP Adjustment Provision, as well as a REP Capital Investment Allowance of \$75,740 which is the revenue requirement associated with \$500,000 of capital spending budgeted for fiscal year 2009.
