This letter serves as official notice of the conversion of Union Telephone Company's support systems for regulated services to TDS Telecom's operational support systems for regulated services. On July 26, 2010, TDS Telecom converted the last of these support systems for regulated services, and considers that date as the completion of the "Transition" as defined in the stipulation approved by the Commission on November 20, 2010.

All of the system conversions were successful, and occurred on schedule. TDS Telecom intends to meet again in September with Staff and OCA representatives to provide an update of the overall transition.
