On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., enclosed is the supplemental information concerning the program costs of the Time-Of-Use ("TOU") Pilot and the Commercial and Industrial Critical Peak Pricing Pilot Program (C&I CPP Pilot) approved by the Commission in Docket DE 09-137. On September 7, 2011, the Company made its initial filing concerning program costs of the TOU and C&I CPP Pilot programs. A portion of these costs was subsequently approved for inclusion in the Default Service Charge rate component effective November 1, 2011.

The information contained herein includes Exhibit 1 Summary of Costs Incurred, consisting of Schedule 1 Summary, Schedule 2 Residential TOU Cost Summary and Schedule 3 C&I CPP Cost Summary, and Exhibit 2 Copies of Invoices. As noted herein, the additional costs incurred subsequent to July 2011 total \$46,140 for the TOU Pilot and \$44,665 for the C&I CPP Pilot.
