Subject: DG 09-168: Cost of Gas Adjustment Monthly Reconciliation, March 2010

Dear Ms. Howland:

In accordance with the Commission's Order No. 25,031, enclosed is an original copy of the monthly calculation of the projected –over/under collection for the 2009-10 winter period.

The computations are based on actual costs and revenues through February and forecasts for the remainder of the period. The calculations indicate a projected over-collection through April 30, 2010 of \$11,034 and would necessitate a (\$0.1196) decrease to the current Cost of Gas Rate of \$1.6374, resulting in a revised COG Rate of \$1.5178 therm. At this time, the Company elects to implement the forecasted increased rate of \$1.5178 therm for the April 1st billing cycle.

Included in this package is an original copy of New Hampshire Gas Corporation's tariff page in compliance with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission's Order No. 25,031 – Order Approving Cost of Gas Rate, issued October 29, 2009.
