PETITION TO INTERVENE


NOW COMES the Office of Energy and Planning (OEP) and respectfully requests leave to intervene as a party in the above-referenced proceeding, pursuant to Rule PUC 203.02 and RSA 541-A:32,I(b). In support of this petition, OEP states the following:

1. OEP represents the Governor on matters pertaining to energy policy.
2. OEP has an ongoing interest in the issues cited by the Commission in its Order of Notices regarding the CORE ratepayer-funded energy efficiency programs. OEP has been an active participant in the stakeholder processes leading to the creation of the CORE programs in 2002, and has intervened in every CORE docket since 2001.
3. OEP is implementing a number of energy efficiency and renewable energy programs funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. The outcome of the aforementioned docket may effect the developments of these programs.
4. OEP's intervention is in the interest of justice and would not impair the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings.

WHEREFORE, OEP requests that the Commission grant this motion, allow OEP to intervene as a party in this proceeding, and grant such other relief as is just and proper.


