PSNH 2010 DEFAULT ENERGY SERVICE RATE CHANGE

Dear Ms. Howland:

I am writing on behalf of Freedom Logistics, LLC (Freedom) and Halifax-American Energy Company, LLC (Halifax) in regard to Order No. 25,048 (November 30, 2009). In the Order, the Commission ordered PSNH to provide copies of the response to TransCanada's question No. 13 to Staff and OCA for their review, as well as provide redacted copies to other parties.

The Order also stated that ... "there are pending issues concerning confidentiality, including a letter filed by Freedom-Halifax on November 12, 2009 asserting that limitations on access to confidential information are unlawful."

Freedom-Halifax has not filed any testimony in this proceeding; it also intends to focus its cross-examination on the PSNH testimony filed on November 23 which addresses customer migration and the resulting effect on the ES rate level. Freedom-Halifax has not issued any data requests on PSNH's November 23 testimony.

Based upon the foregoing, I do not believe that it necessary or appropriate for the Commission to address the issue concerning Freedom-Halifax's access to confidential information in this proceeding as presented in its November 12 letter.
