I am writing on behalf of Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern") regarding Order No. 25,047 issued by the Commission on November 25, 2009 in the above-captioned matter. The Order requires that, among other things, Northern is to file on or before December 15, 2009 a contract whose terms comply with the requirements of the Order. For purposes of complying with this provision, Northern would note that it has already filed a copy of the executed agreement with National Gypsum that effectuates the contract term extension which the Commission has approved on a *nisi* basis in Order No. 25,047. That agreement was submitted with Northern's Petition in the above-captioned matter on October 19, 2009 and is found in Schedule NU-1-4 of the filing.
