# ORDER OF NOTICE

On January 22, 2010, the Commission voted pursuant to RSA 541-A to initiate a rulemaking for N. H. Admin. Rule Puc 3000, Competitive Natural Gas Marketer and Aggregator Rules. The proposal represents a Readoption with amendment of existing Puc 3000 in order to update the rules to reflect changes in the marketplace, to more clearly establish the registration, reporting and financial requirements for covered entities and to clarify or define key terms that were not previously defined or detailed. The proposed rule establishes requirements for the registration of competitive natural gas suppliers and for notification procedures for aggregators with the commission. The rule also establishes consumer protection requirements and enforcement provisions and procedures. Specifically, the proposed rule sets forth definitions of terms, requirements for effective registrations and renewals of registrations, rights and obligations, reporting and financial requirements and methods for enforcement and resolution of disputes. The proposed rule will replace the current version of Puc 3000, which is due to expire on December 28, 2010.

A rulemaking notice form (Notice) required by RSA 541-A:6 was filed with the Office of Legislative Services on May 28, 2010. The Notice sets forth a date for the public hearing to be held at the Commission and the deadline for submission of written comments. This notice is appended hereto.

A copy of the Rulemaking Notice will be sent to all regulated utilities and to those parties previously requesting notice of rulemakings pertaining to competitive electric supplier and

aggregator rules. Pursuant to RSA 541-A:6, III, notice may also be provided by public notice advertisement in a publication of daily statewide circulation.

The readoption with amendment may be viewed on the Commission website, www.puc.nh.gov, or copies may be obtained from the Commission as set forth in the Notice.

# Based upon the foregoing, it is hereby

ORDERED, that a Public Hearing, pursuant to 541-A:11, be held before the Commission located at 21 S. Fruit St Suite 10, Concord, New Hampshire on July 15, 2010 at 10:00 a.m., and that the deadline for submission of materials in writing or via e-mail shall be July 22, 2010, as set forth in the Notice; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to RSA 541-A:6,III, the Commission shall undertake a public notice advertisement by publishing a copy of this Order together with the Notice no later than June 24, 2010, in a newspaper with a daily statewide circulation, publication to be documented by affidavit filed with the Commission on or before July 15, 2010.

6. (a) Summary of what the rule says and the effect of the rule on those regulated:

Puc 3000 sets forth the registration and reporting requirements for competitive natural gas suppliers and aggregators of natural gas customers. The rule requires these entities to register with the Public Utilities Commision prior to conducting business in New Hampshire and sets out the requirements for an effective registration. For competitive suppliers, such persons or entities must also demonstrate that they are approved shippers on necessary natural gas pipelines, and they must post a bond or financial security and submit annual reports on their sales and customers in this state, as well as the aggregators with whom they do business. In addition, the rule defines various consumer protection requirements relating to competitive suppliers and aggregators. Also, the rule defines various enforcement mechanisms available to the Public Utilities Commission and consumers.

The amendments to Puc 3000 define and clarify key terms within Puc 3000 which were not previously defined or detailed. In addition, the amendments clarify the requirements and timing for initial registrations and renewals as well as the reporting requirements for financial security and customer reports.

6. (b) Brief description of the groups affected: These rules and amendments affect persons or entities engaged, or intending to be engaged, in the competitive sale of natural gas supply in this state or in the aggregation of natural gas customers.
