On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, I enclose for filing seven copies of N.H.P.U.C. No. 3, Tariff Page 110 which contains the Company's on-bill financing provision associated with its RE-CORE Programs. These programs have been approved by the Governor and Executive Council and thus this tariff is being submitted in accordance with that approval.
