On April 5, 2010, Conservation Service Group (CSG) filed an application on behalf of Nexamp, Inc. requesting that the Commission grant approval of its Nexamp PD Solar Aggregation in Massachusetts to produce Class II renewable energy certificates pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law. On April 29, 2010, Staff sent an email requesting additional information to Emma Kosciak of Nexamp, Inc. to which Ms. Kosciak responded stating that, since CSG was no longer managing this and other Nexamp accounts, Nexamp requested that the Commission freeze the application such that Nexamp can pursue the application at a later time. In an email dated May 5, 2010, Ms. Kosciak asked Commission Staff to close the application until Nexamp finds a new aggregator for its facilities. Staff has not received a request to reopen the application and, as a result, Staff recommends that the Commission close this docket without prejudice.
