



	• There is NO fee to renew an aggregator's registration <u>provided</u> that the renewal notice of intent is made in a timely manner.
	• Each aggregator shall re-file with the Commission an up-to-date written notice of intent to provide service as an aggregator every 2 years on or before its original notice anniversary date, which is the date on which the Commission received the applicant's <u>initial</u> notice of intent.
	<ul> <li>Unless additional time is required to review the notice of intent and the Commission extends the review period, an aggregator may begin operating within the state 45 days after filing a completed notice of intent with the Commission.</li> </ul>


