Notice of Pre-Hearing Conference Petition for Increase in Rates PENNICHUCK WATER WORKS, INC. July 14, 2010 2:00 p.m. Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) has petitioned the

Permichtick water works, inc. (Pww) has petitioned the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of an increase to its rates. PWW has asked for a temporary increase of 10.80% and an overall permanent increase of 19.91% which the company proposes implement-ing in two phases. PWW's request for this increase is based on increases in its operating costs as well as investment in its plant and treatment systems to ensure continued com-pliance with the Safe Drinking Water Act. The increase would apply to all customers. The increase for PWW residential general metered customers would be as follows:
