On June 2, 2010, Holyoke Gas & Elec On June 2, 2010, ringoke Gas & Eactific Department (HC&E) of Holyoke, Massachusetts filed an application for certification of fourteen small hydroelectric facilities as sources eligible to produce Class IV renewable energy certificates (RECs) pursuant to RSA 362-F:4, the Electric Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) law. After reviewing the application, the Commission denied certification be-cause the HGME system is a canal system and each facility on the system does not have installed upstream and downstream diadromous fish passages as required by RSA 362-F4. IV On September 10, 2010, HG&E appealed the Commission's denial, resulting in the initiation of an adjudicative proceeding pursuant to N.H. Code Admin, Rules Puc 2505.13.

The Commission issued an Order of Notice on October 28, 2010 which, among other things, required HG&E to publish the notice in a newspaper with general circulation in those portions of the state in which operations are conducted.
