
On behalf of Energy North Natural Gas, Inc. d/b/a Liberty Utilities ("the Company"), I am writing to inform the Commission that, as authorized by the Settlement Agreement dated December 15, 2010 and Section V(B)(1) of Order No. 25,189, approving the Settlement Agreement, the Company will be transferring funds within the Commercial and Industrial ("C&I") and Residential sectors of its CORE gas energy efficiency programs in order to meet year end demand for particular programs.

The table below reflects the approved budgets for the 2012 CORE New Hampshire Energy Efficiency programs and the transfers. As noted in the table, the Company intends to transfer \$151,149 from the Energy Audit w/Home Performance Program and direct \$146,599 to the High Efficiency Htg Equipment and \$4,550 to the Building Practices and Demo programs. In addition, the Company intends to transfer \$267,002 from the Large Retrofit program into the New Equipment & Construction program. Each of these transfers is within the 20% limit specified in Order 25,189. See Order 25,189 at 21-22.
