In compliance with the Commission's Order No. 25,200 dated March 4, 2011 in Docket DE 10-192 (Electric Assistance Program – Order Approving Program Changes), the following tariff pages are transmitted herewith:

In its Order No. 25,200, the Commission approved changes to the design of the Electric Assistance Program (EAP) that were proposed by the EAP Advisory Board as a result of the expiration of the re-allocation of the System Benefits Charge as of June 30, 2011. The enclosed tariff pages eliminate the tier 1 discount to new applicants as of March 4, 2011. On or before July 1, 2011, PSNH will file revised tariff pages implementing the second aspect of the Commission's order, which will limit the discount under Residential Electric Assistance Program Rate EAP to the first 700 kilowatt-hours of use per month.
