Dear New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission:

This letter is written on behalf of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berlin. At their meeting on Monday, September 27, 2010, on a vote of 5-3, the Mayor and Council voted to provide you with this letter in support of PSNH's Petition to the PUC for Approval of a Power Purchase Agreement between PSNH and Laidlaw Berlin BioPower, LLC (DE 10-195) and to urge the expedited consideration of its petition.

The City of Berlin is by far the most economically distressed city in the state. It desperately needs the enterprise, jobs and tax base that the proposed Laidlaw energy development project will bring to the community. In order to take advantage of close to \$3,000,000 in local community benefits from New Market Tax Credits which have been allocated to the project, final financing must close by November 15, 2010. This financing cannot close without a Power Purchase Agreement.

As the Commission is aware, Laidlaw has just completed what is a 9-month process before the Site Evaluation Committee process. The project is now ready to begin construction. The City fully expects that the PUC will carry out its review process with proper due diligence. The City also respectfully requests that the PUC do everything in its power to streamline that review to make it as rapid as reasonably possible.

The PUC's judicious and timely review of this petition is greatly appreciated.
