## In Case No. 2011-0348, <u>Appeal of Bridgewater Power</u> <u>Company, LP & a.</u>, the court on August 18, 2011, issued the following order:

Motion for expedited treatment of court's review of discretionary appeal and for expedited review of motion for summary dismissal is granted. Motion for summary dismissal is denied.

Appeal from a decision of the State of New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission is accepted and will be scheduled for oral argument before the full court.

On or before October 17, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission shall file with the supreme court a certified copy of the record in the proceeding. The certified copy of the record shall include a table of contents with references to the page of the record at which each item listed in the table of contents begins. <u>See</u> Rule 10(3). Unless the moving party requests that a transcript be prepared, in compliance with the administrative agency's regulations and/or RSA 541-A:31, no transcript will be prepared for inclusion in the record. <u>See</u> Rule 10(2) Note. If a transcript of the proceeding before the Public Utilities Commission is requested, it shall be filed with the certified copy of the record.
