Question:

In his testimony dated July 26, 2010, at pages 4-5, Mr. Large states that the number of customers that have migrated from PSNH to competitive suppliers has increased substantially, but that PSNH still projects an energy gap between resources and supply of between 1,100,000 to 3,746,000 MWh per year and a capacity gap of between 401 to 1073 MWs for 2014, depending upon varying forecasts of customer sales and migration.

- a. Please provide all studies or analyses supporting the forecasts referred to by Mr. Large. Please state all assumptions made, and provide all work papers, projections, analyses, and documents, relating to these forecasts.
- b. Did PSNH study, analyze, or otherwise forecast the resource/supply and capacity gap for the 20-year term of the PPA? If so, please state all assumptions made, and provide all related work papers, projections, studies, analyses, and documents.
- c. Did PSNH study, analyze, or otherwise forecast the effect that the Laidlaw PPA would have on customer sales and migration? If so, what conclusions did PSNH reach? Please provide the studies, analyses or forecasts pertaining thereto and state all assumptions made, and provide all related work papers, projections, analyses, and documents.
