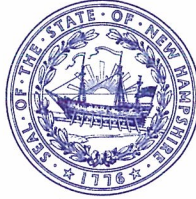

Re: DE 10-212, Commercial and Industrial Solar Rebate Program
Technical Session for Stakeholder Review of Potential Program Changes

To Interested Persons:

A technical session will be held on October 7, 2015 starting at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 21 South Fruit Street, Suite 10, Concord, New Hampshire, in order for interested stakeholders to review and discuss potential changes to the commercial and industrial solar rebate incentive program.

Potential program changes may include a reduction in incentive payment levels, imposition of maximum incentive amounts, modification of capacity size limitations, revision of applicant caps, changes in application and documentation requirements, and modifications to other program terms and conditions.

Commission Staff anticipates that a more detailed description of potential program changes may be provided to stakeholders at or prior to the technical session, and these suggested changes would be the primary focus of discussion at the session.

Following this technical session, Staff intends to prepare a formal recommendation regarding program changes for consideration by the Commission, and this recommendation would be the subject of a public comment hearing and written comment submission period. It is likely that the program modification approval and implementation process will not be completed until November or later.
