

B. Conditions and Limitations (Continued)

5. Simplicity Package customers are not eligible for discounts or promotional offerings outside of this Package, unless specifically provided for in a promotional offering.
6. The Package may not be combined with any other optional toll calling plan service, except for those specified in this offering.
7. Customers who fail to pay the entire Package rate per month will have all Simplicity Package optional features removed. The customer will then be converted to the tariffed Basic Local service rate. Service Charges will not apply for converting services back to tariff rates. Such customers will not be permitted to re-enroll in any of the Packages until such time as all associated unpaid balances are satisfactorily paid in full.


