The Commission received your joint filing with RCC Atlantic, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Wireless for New Hampshire dated September 8, 2010. The filing further amends the interconnection agreement (Agreement) between the parties dated March 21, 1997 and approved by the Commission in Docket No. DE 97-076 by Order No. 22,587 (May 2, 1997), amended on May 19, 1997 and June 14, 2001.

The Amendment, numbered 3, provides access to 911/E911 services and incorporates the associated rates, terms and conditions for this offering. The amendments include applicable definitions in Section 1.0, a 911 wireless attachment (described as Exhibit A to the Agreement) and amendments to the compensation arrangements regarding 911/E911 (Type 2C) services.

The Commission elects to take no action on this petition. Accordingly, pursuant to 47 USC 252(e)(4), the amendment to the Agreement will take effect by operation of law 90 days after its filing, or on or about December 7, 2010. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any clause in the Agreement found to be in violation of any Commission order is null and void.
