2010 Least Cost Integrated Resource Plan (LCIRP) Request for Third Modification of Procedural Schedule

Dear Ms. Howland:

The Commission, by secretarial letter, approved Staff's proposed procedural schedule on the instant docket on December 28, 2010; this schedule was modified, at Staff's request, by secretarial letters on February 24, 2011, and March 31, 2011.

On April 26, 2011, PSNH informed Staff and the various parties that significant errors in its LCIRP filing had been uncovered. In particular, PSNH found significant errors in the Newington Station Continuing Unit Operation Study (Newington CUO) prepared by Levitan & Associates, of Boston, Massachusetts (Levitan). PSNH submitted revisions (or, New Levitan Data) prepared by Levitan on its behalf, which appear to have a significant impact on the mathematical results presented within the Newington CUO. In light of this, Staff finds it advisable to integrate additional discovery features into the procedural schedule to enable Staff and the other parties to properly assess the Newington CUO in light of the New Levitan Data.

To that end, Staff requests a modification of the procedural schedule as follows:
