Renewal Registration as a Natural Gas Aggregator

Dear Ms. Loop:

On October 7, 2010, World Energy Solutions, Inc. d/b/a World Green Exchange (World Green) filed with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) an application for renewal registration as a natural gas aggregator.

The Commission has reviewed World Energy's renewal application for registration as a natural gas aggregator and has determined that its application meets the requirements for registration pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (Adopted Rule 9/24/10). Accordingly, the Commission has approved World Energy as a natural gas aggregator in the State of New Hampshire, effective January 1, 2011, which coincides with the expiration of World Energy's current aggregator registration. The renewed registration will expire on December 31, 2015.

Please bear in mind that, pursuant to N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3003.05 (a) and (e), each aggregator must re-register after the initial 2 year period or after a 5 year renewal period as applicable by filing with the Commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of its registration and notify any LDC in whose service territory it intends to do business of the filing of its registration or renewal application at the time it files such an application with the Commission. World Energy's application for renewal would be due November 1, 2015.
