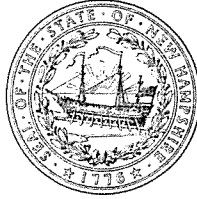

Withdrawal of Registration as an Electric Load Aggregator

Dear Ms. Parker:

On July 30, 2014, you filed a request with the Commission to withdraw the registration of Northeast Energy Partners, LLC (Northeast Energy) as an electric load aggregator in New Hampshire. In your letter, you stated that Northeast Energy requests to withdraw its registration as of June 30, 2014, and you represented that Northeast Energy has not served any retail customers during the past 90 days. You also stated that, on October 3, 2012, World Energy Solutions, Inc. acquired substantially all of the assets and certain obligations of Northeast Energy.

The Commission's rules governing electric load aggregators do not provide for the withdrawal, rescission or abandonment of an aggregator's registration. The Commission has reviewed your letter and has deemed it a request for waivers of N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2003.04 (g) (approved aggregator registration valid for two years), and Puc 2003.04 (i) (registered aggregator to continue compliance with requirements of Puc 2000). The Commission has determined that the requested waivers, without any further conditions, are in the public interest and will not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission, and that the purpose of the rules will be satisfied by the termination of Northeast Energy's electric load aggregator registration, effective as of the date specified in the request letter.

Accordingly, Northeast Energy's electric load aggregator registration is deemed withdrawn and terminated, effective as of June 30, 2014.
