In this filing FairPoint Communications – NNE is revising certain tariff language pertaining to Business Basic Exchange Service term commitments. The language change states that at the end of the customer's term, the agreement will automatically be renewed at the same terms and conditions unless either party provides advance notice that it does not wish to renew the term. The language change also provides a 60 day grace period at the beginning of each subsequent automatic renewal for the subscriber to unsubscribe from the plan without penalty.
