Re: DM 11-171, Notification of MRDB Holdings LP's Intent to Provide Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Ms. Sim:

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received MRDB Holdings LP (MRDB)'s notice of intent to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to N. H. Code of Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. In its application, MRDB requested a waiver of Puc 2003.05(a) requiring an application for renewal be filed no less than 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration. MRDB's renewal application was due 60 days before its registration expiration date of July 20, 2011 and the Commission received the application on August 5, 2011. MRDB stated that delays resulted from a recent change in personnel and internal transfer of its records and files. MRDB further mentioned that it has complied with the obligations set forth in Puc 2000 and it did not have any changes to the information that was submitted to the Commission in its previous application.

On October 3, 2011, Staff filed a recommendation that MRDB be registered as a provider of electric aggregation service and that the Commission grant the waiver request inasmuch as MRDB has been timely in its registration renewals since 2007.

The Commission may waive a rule pursuant to Puc 201.05 if it finds the waiver serves the public interest and the waiver does not disrupt the orderly and efficient resolution of matters before the Commission. Based on the foregoing, the Commission has concluded that the applicable standards for a waiver are satisfied and the requested waiver is consistent with the public good.


Therefore, based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission will approve the renewal of MRDB's registration as a provider of electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

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Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.05 (f): “[E]ach approved aggregator shall re-notify the commission after the initial 2 year period, or after the 5 year renewal period as applicable, by filing with the commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration.” MRDB’s original notice anniversary date is July 20, 2007 and therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before **May 20, 2016** if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, MRDB is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.08, customer protections provided by aggregators.
