To the Parties:

Docket No. DE 11-184 seeks approval of purchased power agreements between Public Service Company of New Hampshire and five small power producers. According to pleadings filed in the New Hampshire Supreme Court in Docket No. 2011-0348, the agreements have been negotiated over a number of weeks between the small power producers, PSNH, and principals developing the Berlin BioPower biomass facility. It is apparent that Governor Lynch was instrumental in convening the parties and that his counsel, Jeffrey Meyers, to whom I am married, was a direct participant in negotiations leading to the agreements filed with the Commission. He and I have not discussed the negotiations or terms of the agreements.
