On September 26, 2011, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from America's Wood Company's requesting certification for the photovoltaic facility sited at 598 Augusta Road, Washington, ME as a Class II renewable energy source pursuant to RSA 362-F, New Hampshire's Renewable Portfolio Standard law.

Upon review of your application staff has noted two areas where we need either modified or additional information:

1. Your application lists Central Maine Power Company as your independent monitor. The PUC will need verification that the Central Maine Power Company is acting as an independent monitor for your area, and that they meet all the requirements of the Puc 2505.09 rules.
2. America's Wood Company must obtain a GIS facility code number before we can consider the application complete. James Webb, GIS Administrator stated that the process to obtain a GIS unit ID number shouldn't take more than 2 or 3 days if you are starting a new account. Submission of the above modification and verification must be received by the Commission to complete your application. Until such time, it cannot be processed. If the

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requested information and documentation are not provided within ten business days, your file will be closed without prejudice. Please refer to docket number DE 11-180 in all
