On May 19, 2016, Merrimack County Telephone Company and Wilton Telephone Company (MCTC and WTC, or collectively TDS) petitioned the Commission to grant an extension to TDS for use of two full codes of telephone numbers in the 603 area code. On May 24, 2016, the Commission extended the deadline for TDS to relinquish the MCTC code to May 31, 2017, and extended the deadline for TDS to relinquish the WTC code to May 31, 2019.

Both codes have now been returned. TDS has informed Staff that the MCTC code was returned to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) effective December 23, 2016, and the WTC code was returned to NANPA effective January 27, 2017.

Staff has used NANPA database tools to confirm that both codes have been returned and are available for use, no longer associated with a particular rate center. This docket may be closed.
