Dear Ms. Howland:

As you know, Commission Staff conducted a second technical session in the above-referenced docket on Wednesday, June 15, 2005. Please treat this letter as Staff's report of the technical session.

Participating in the technical session along with Staff were representatives of Verizon New Hampshire (Verizon), the Office of Consumer Advocate, Bay Ring, Conversent, segTEL, and, participating by telephone, Great Works Internet (GWI), CTC Communications-Lightship, Covad Communications Company (Covad), and Broadview.

All of the above-named participants have signed a Protective Agreement with Verizon with regard to information provided in this docket. Staff has received releases from all but one of the twelve CLECs identified by Verizon as fiber-based collocators pursuant to the FCC TRO Remand Order (Remand Order).

Discussion centered on the definition of fiber-based collocation in an incumbent wire center pursuant to the Remand Order. No consensus was reached as to the scope of such definition, although Parties reached agreement as to certain scenarios that meet the definition.

Participants agreed that Staff will send an illustrated listing of possible collocation scenarios to assist CLECs in identifying their particular type of collocation arrangement in Verizon wire centers.
